

The driver of the mixture is 30% Barolympic perennial ryegrass. Barolympic is the stand-out cultivar ryegrass for summer sports use and is ranked #1 with a score of 8.6 in Table G4 of BSPB Turfgrass Seed 2018, the highest mean score in the entire publication, and more than a full point clear of its nearest rival in G4!

Barolympic is also a good all-rounder for all areas of ryegrass usage. As an average of tables G4 (green) L1 (lawn) and S1 (sport), it is ranked #1 of all available cultivars.

In addition to its outstanding mean scores, Barolympic is ranked #1 for pale colour and #2 for fineness of leaf in Tables L1 and G4. This makes it exceptionally easy to blend in with other grass species, such as red fescue or annual meadowgrass.

The red fescue cultivars in the mix are both consistent performers, with Barcrown ranked #3 and Bargreen II #7 for greens use in tables G3 and G2, respectively.
