

Overview:

- White clover is added to provide a supply of nutrients on impoverished soils
- Rapid germination from annual ryegrass which acts as a nurse crop
- Creeping and deep-rooted grasses for soil stabilisation
- · Very tolerant of harsh conditions
- Available without white clover, see E16 Embankment and Ground Cover

Areas of use:

- Embankments
- · Areas of loose and unstable soils
- · Road verges

IN THE BAG

20% Perennial ryegrass

20% Strong creeping red fescue

15% Annual ryegrass

15% Slender creeping red fescue

15% Tall fescue

10% Hard fescue

5% Bent

5% White Clover

HOW TO USE IT

Pack Size - 20kg Sowing rate - 25-50g/m²

Cutting Height - Down to 50mm

(A high sowing rate is recommended when sowing on steep banks.)
